FARN DEEPS NEPHROPS SURVEY

- DURATION: 9-13 November 2004
- LOCALITY: Farn Deeps grounds, fishing from North Shields
- AIMS: 1. To describe commercial catch rates of *Nephrops* in the vicinity of underwater camera tows carried out on the Farn Deeps grounds in October 2004 by CEFAS.
 - 2. To describe the size composition and mean size of *Nephrops* in the vicinity of underwater camera tows.
 - 3. To describe the catch rates of fish by-catch species taken during trawling for *Nephrops* in different areas of the Farn Deeps grounds.
 - 4. To describe the variation in commercial catch rates of *Nephrops* and by-catch species according to location, vessel and time of day.
- **PLAN:** CEFAS staff will travel to North Shields by hired vehicle on 9 November. The survey will be undertaken using the vessels FV Kristenbourg and FV Star Divine fishing day trips over the five days 8-12 November 2004. A CEFAS SIC will be assigned to each vessel, and the third scientist will alternate between the two vessels. Prioritised lists of stations have been provided for each vessel. At each station, a 0.5 hour tow will be undertaken using unmodified commercial *Nephrops* trawl gear. Full and reduced sampling protocols have been provided for 2- or 1-scientist operation respectively.

Staff will return to Lowestoft on 13 November.
