- 2. To use an underwater still camera to investigate a patch of juvenile scallops located in 1991.
- 3. To obtain 1991/92 catch/effort data from FV ROCKHOPPER logbook.

PLAN:

Staff will travel to Portscatho on 15 November. FV ROCKHOPPER will be chartered for 3 days from 16 November to carry out a scallop survey, using fine-mesh and commercial dredges, on our standard set of ground within the 3 mile zone.

In the event of bad weather interruptions, staff will visit port offices and SFCs as opportunity affords.
