Locality

Suffolk coast.

Aims

- 1. To make a complete routine survey of Sizewell Bank for 1-group sole using the standard 2 m beam trawl.
- 2. To carry out comparative fishing trials using the 2 m beam trawl, modifications of this trawl and the 2 m Agassiz trawl.
 - 3. To release seabed and surface drifters.
 - 4. To collect adult flatfish for hatchery use.
 - 5. To make an Otter trawl survey for larger sole off Sizewell.

Narrative

On 4 and 5 March maturing flounders were collected near the Barnard but a search further south and east failed to find useful numbers of the other species required. 6 and 7 March were lost due to bad weather. On 8 March the routine survey of Sizevell Bank for 1-group sole was completed with the standard 2 m beam trawl and a second 2 m trawl with a much heavier and spiked tickler chain.

After a further period of bad and indifferent weather when only Otter trawling was possible, the survey of Sizewell Bank was repeated on 12 March using the standard 2 m beam trawl and the 2 m Agassiz, used together.

Rosults

- 1. The routine surveys using the 2 m beam trawl on 8 and 12 March both produced much lower numbers of all 0-group and 1-group flatfish than were found in December, 1967.
- 2. The surveys with the heavier tickler chains and the Agassiz trawl, which were undertaken to discover whether the young flatfish were more deeply buried, did not produce more 1-group sole than the standard 2 m beam trawl.
- 3. Scabed and surface drifters were released at low water on 8 March and at high water on 12 March.
- 4. All the adult flounders required by Dr. Purdom and Mr. Riley were collected but no maturing dab or sole were found within the inshore grounds fished.
- 5. Otter trawling off Sizewell Bank in 6, 9 and 21 fathoms produced no adult sole.
