LOCATION: Thames, Medway, Swale and Essex Estuaries

AIMS: 1. To carry a trawl survey for pre-recruit bass in the middle

Thames estuary, Medway, Swale, Essex Blackwater, Crouch

and Roach Estuaries over established grid stations.

2. To determine the relative abundance of bass and other

species in the Thames and adjoining estuaries.

3. To obtain samples of flatfish for environmental monitoring

programmes.

4. To obtain sample of 100 0-group bass for an experiment on

feeding ecology of juvenile bass using stable isotopes.

PLAN:

CEFAS staff will travel to Leigh-on Sea on the 5th November and will meet the charter vessel that day to load the survey gear. EA staff will join the vessel on the morning of 6th November and the survey will commence that day and continue for 6 days. It is intended to complete approximately 35 tows using twin bass trawls fitted with shrimp-mesh cod-end liners. The survey will work from Leigh-on-Sea and Wallasea marina and the order of working in each area will be dependent on weather and local tidal conditions. CEFAS staff will return to Lowestoft on the evening of the 11th November.
