### **Report**

Staff travelled to Millport on 1 November. Trawling commenced on 2 November around the Garroch Head area (within 1.5 miles of centre). Plaice were measured, sexed and kept alive in tanks for transportation back to Millport.

Trawling took place on 3 November in the channel one mile off Millport to obtain 10 plaice for control sample. Livers and flesh from these fish were sampled at the Marine Biological Station on 3 and 4 November. Samples were subsequently frozen for transportation back to Aberdeen.
