CRUISE REPORT

F.R.S. "CLUPEA"

October 1st-13th, 1962.

---

Objective

To undertake a routine survey of the Moray Firth.

All stations were completed. Halfin herring were caught in small quantities in the upper Firth with a size range of between 16-21 cms. There were very few sprats caught. The white fish catch was quite good with whiting the predominant species.

At the end of the survey 485 trawl caught herring were successfully tagged off Findhorn. One tagged fish was retrieved three days after release from the Beaully Firth.
