Objective

To carry out instrumented fishing gear trials working in cooperation with the chartered pair seine vessels Alba (BF46) and Tyleana (BF61).

Narrative

Staff and equipment travelled to Fraserburgh on 25 July. Shipboard instrumentation was installed on all three vessels and one partly instrumented haul was made north of Fraserburgh that afternoon.
