Aim

To make a joint Tin Tow Net survey with CLIONE of the distribution of plaice eggs and larvae in the southern North Sea.

Narrative

CORELLA departed from Lowestoft at 1600 hours, 11 February, and proceeded to the northwest corner of the survey grid which was commenced at 0200 hours the following morning. The ship had to start dodging in a northeast gale at 1300 hours, 12 February, and work did not start again until 0150 hours the following day. CORELLA's part of the survey was completed by 1240 hours, 14 February. The vessel anchored off Corton during the night of 14/15 February and docked at Lowestoft at 0745 hours, 15 February.
