Report

Objective

A routine demersal fish survey in the Northern North Sea.

Narrative

'Explorer' sailed from Aberdeen on & October and proceeded to stations 120 miles East of Peterhead. Despite adverse weather conditions trawling was successively completed in the South-east corner of the survey area. Deteriorating weather caused 'Explorer' to steam to Shetland to work in the comparative calm to the West of the Islands. A temporary lull permitted 'Explorer' to work the grounds around Fair Isle before running to shelter in Dalesvoe. 'Explorer' docked at Lerwick on Monday 18 October where she was joined by Mr Newton. Due to the sudden recall of one of the catering staff the vessel was delayed in Lerwick until a replacement joined the ship on Thursday. 'Explorer' immediately proceeded to stations East of Shetland and worked SE and then SW into the Moray Firth. A severe gale caused the vessel to shelter in Aberdour Bay on Tuesday 26 October from where 'Explorer' proceeded to Aberdeen on Wednesday 27 October to off-load gear before finally docking in Leith on Thursday 28 October.

Results

Using an Aberdeen 48' trawl, a total of 34 one hour hauls were made in the survey area. Table 1 shows the average number of haddock, whiting, cod and Norway pout caught per hour in each of the sampling regions. In the case of haddock and whiting these figures are broken down further by age groupings (these groupings were selected by using abitrary lengths).

During the cruise the total and gutted weights were obtained from 687 fish, mainly cod, haddock and whiting. Stomachs of mackerel and large cod were examined in accordance with the ICES stomach programme.

Thirty <u>Scyliorhinus stellaris</u> and 3 halibut were transported back alive to the Laboratory. In addition, 20 kgs of cod liver and a number of haddock were returned to the Laboratory for heavy metal and parasitological investigations respectively.
