OBJECTIVE

Development trials of an underwater television carrying vehicle.

Goldseeker loaded as planned and arrived at Fort Augustus PN on Tuesday 14 April. The trials were carried out in Loch Ness without interruption, until PM on the 23 April when she sailed for Clachnaharry where offloading was completed early on Friday 24 April.

RESULT

Only the two major components within the trials need mention in this report.

- 1. The new 32mm diameter tow/service cable proved operable. The performance of the system was reduced, but only marginally, whilst the benefits to be obtained by the use of such a cable from a winch, would more than compensate.
- 2. New six inch diameter rotors were also tried and the resulting observations would suggest on improved performance for the vehicle of no less than 30%.

The relevant data will be the subject of a much fuller internal report.
