1 - 25 July 1980

Objectives

- 1. To determine the visibility of tagging techniques in growth study experiments on <u>Dichelopendalus</u> bonnieri.
- 2. To study the abundance of <u>Mephrops</u> and <u>D</u>. <u>bonnieri</u> on grounds between Kylc and Gairloch.

Narrative

The scientific staff joined "Goldseeker" at Corpoch on 1/7/80. The boat steemed to Gairloch arriving there on 3/7/80, having shot creeks in outer Loch Torridon.

A programme of trawling was undertaken in the waters off Gairloch and Loch Torridon, and in the Sound of Raasay. Creeks were shot and hauled at intervals in outer Loch Torridon.

"Goldseekor" steamed to Kyle at the weekend, where stores, fuel and ships mail were collected.

On 21/7/80 "Goldsecker" left Kyle for Oben and some trawl hauls were made in the Lynn of Lorne and in Loch Linnhe. "Goldsecker" entered the Caledonian Canal at Corpoch on 22/7/80 and arrived at Buckie at 2300 on 23/7/80. The scientific staff left the boat at Buckie on 24/7/80.

Results

In the area between Gairloch and the Sound of Raasay 18 half hour hauls were made using a 45 mm "Goldseeker" shrimps trawl with 35 mm codend, and 4 half hour trawl hauls using a standard 70 mm prawn trawl.

Catches of <u>Mephrops</u> were frir to good, 89 kg being caught with the 45 mm not and 25 kg with the 70 mm net. <u>Pandrlus</u> sp. were scarce, catches were pour and only 8.5 kg were caught. In the Sound of Raasay small haddock were abundant. Six baskets of haddock size range 16 - 37 cm, the majority of fish being in the range 17 - 23 cm were caught in two hauls. Fish catches elsewhere were poor, and consisted mainly of spotted dogfish.

Three trawl hauls using the 45 mm net and 35 mm codend were mode in the Lynn of Lorne and Loch Linnhe. 17 kg and Nephrops and 0.5 kg of Pandalus were caught. In the Lynn of Lorne the haul also produced 222 sprats at a size of 7 - 8 cm.

The size composition of the Nephrops catches is given in Table I.

The creel catches in Loch Torridon amounted to 225 Nephrops and 14.5 kg of Munida rugosa. Some Pandalids were caught, but these proved to be too small to tag successfully. 51 Nephrops were tagged and released.

The size composition of creel caught Nephrops and Munida are shown in Table II and Table III
