Objectives

To undertake a study of demersal pair trawling using both underwater television and instrumentation.

Narrative

Although the RCTV and other trials equipment was loaded in Buckie on 30 August adverse weather conditions kept "Goldseeker" in port until the evening of 31 August when she steamed north to wick overnight. The chartered vessels "Aquila" and "Poseidon" arrived in wick on 1 September. The three vessels worked together until 15 September, either south east of wick or in Sinclair Bay, as weather conditions and underwater visibility permitted. "Goldseeker" returned to Buckie on 16 September where equipment was unloaded for return to Aberdeen.

Results

A total of 2% hauls, 4 fully instrumented, 6 partly instrumented, were made. The RCTV system was operated from "Goldseeker" on %4 of these hauls and 6 hours of underwater video tape material was recorded.
