## Objectives

1 To measure the engineering performance of a seine net.

2 To observe a seine net using the underwater vehicle "SEAPUP".

## Narrative

"Jenmar" arrived in Stornoway early on 16 June to commence fishing trials in the Broad Bay area and continued fishing until 29 June. Joint operations were conducted with the FRV "Goldseeker", the latter serving as a base for operating SEAPUP. The latter vehicle was used to observe fishing gears from 26-29 June. Staff and equipment returned to Aberdeen on 1 July.

## Results

A total of 44 seine net hauls were made, of which 19 were fully instrumented. Twenty TV hauls were carried out in collaboration with FRV "Goldseeker". The data collected will be analysed in the Laboratory.
