## AIMS

- To conduct a routine monitoring survey of the Liverpool Bay sewage sludge dumpsite.
- 2. To conduct a survey of the benthos and sediments at dredged spoil disposal sites with grab.

## NARRATIVE

No survey work was conducted on 12 or 13 September, due to bad weather. PRINCE MADOG sailed to Liverpool Bay on the morning of 14 September, where a series of 24 grab stations were worked for benthos and sediments (UCNW and MAFF). A further 34 stations were worked on 15 September, and 12 on 16 September in order to complete the grid. PRINCE MADOG docked at Menai Bridge at 1430 h. 16 September.
