# **Objectives**

- 1. To undertake water, sediment-and biological sampling for the National Marine Monitoring Programme (NMMP).
- 2. To collect water samples for hydrographic studies.

Days per project: AE11p, 7 days

### Narrative

Scotia sailed 7 January at 1100 hours to the NMMP Tay/Forth site where sampling commenced at 1500 hours. The NMMP sites in the Moray Firth and the Minches were sampled on 8 and 9 January. Scotia then made passage to the Clyde NMMP site. The NMMP sites at the Clyde and the Solway Firth were sampled on the 10 and 11 January. Scotia docked in Aberdeen at the end of the cruise at 1700 hours on 12 January.

During passage, water samples were collected between the Mull of Kintyre and Wick for hydrographic analysis.

### Results

All Scottish NMMP offshore sites were occupied. At all sites water, sediment and sediment samples were obtained. Additional sediment and water samples were collected in the vicinity of the trawl ground at NMMP site 85. A sufficient return of the target species (plaice) was obtained at all but one of the NMMP sites, namely the Firth of Clyde.
