CRUISE REPORT

F.R.S. "SCOTIA"

9th - 17th June, 1966

Aims To collect the stomachs of roundfish from selected
areas in the North Sea.

Fishing was first carried out on the edge of rough ground
in the region of Coral Bank. Five hauls were made there,
but fishing proved unsatisfactory and the grounds were changed
to a second position near 58°00'N 2°00'W. Weather conditions
throughout the cruise were good and a further 29 hauls were
made at this position before the ship returned to Aberdeen
on 15th June.

A considerable number of roundfish stomachs were
collected and preserved for subsequent analysis in the
Laboratory.
