### **Objective**

To undertake a demersal trawling survey of the North Sea.

**Out-turn days per project:** 21 days DAC1

### **Narrative**

*Scotia* sailed from Aberdeen at 1030 hours on 3 August and commenced work on the trawling stations off the east coast of Scotland. During the second haul of 4 August it became clear that one of the trawl doors was not operating properly. Due to the time lost in changing the trawl doors, work was limited to four stations for the day. With weather conditions being favourable *Scotia* was able to complete the stations off the east coast and the southern part of the survey area before entering Danish territorial waters on 7 August. Work continued uninterrupted on the eastern edge of the survey area until *Scotia* docked at Stavanger on 11 August for the mid-cruise break. The vessel sailed the following morning and continued to work northwards, clearing the Norwegian sector at midnight on 14 August. A deterioration in weather conditions in the early hours of 16 August resulted in the vessel moving from the west of Shetland to the east of the islands where better conditions allowed work to continue. Trawling continued in the Shetland and Orkney regions until the evening of 19 August when *Scotia* had to stop off at Macduff to land one of the scientific staff who had taken ill and pick up a replacement. The vessel then restarted work off the north east coast before completing the survey area on 22 August. *Scotia* docked in Aberdeen on the evening of 22 August.

### **Results**

The survey area was fully covered with a total of 87 valid hauls being completed. Water samples and temperatures were collected from 67 stations.

The number of 0-group haddock and whiting caught per hour in each statistical rectangle are shown in Figures 1 and 2 respectively. The numbers of cod, haddock, whiting, saithe and Norway pout caught per 10 hours fishing during the August ground fish surveys since 1982 are shown in Tables 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 respectively. While the numbers of 0-group haddock caught were below the average, the number of 1-group (1994 year class) were the highest since the survey commenced. The number of 0-group whiting caught were greater than the previous two years and above the series average. Catches of 1-group Norway pout caught were considerably higher than in any of the previous surveys.

Length frequency, haul summary data and age data for cod, haddock, saithe and Norway pout were punched at sea and stored on micro-computer. The scanmar system was used throughout the cruise to monitor headline height, wing spread and distance covered during each haul.



August 1995 Haddock 0-group nos/hour


