AIMS:

- To carry out a groundfish survey along the North Wales coast. 1.
- To collect samples of otoliths of commercial species. 2.
- To obtain samples of ungutted plaice and whiting for contaminant trend analysis work 3. (A Franklin, Burnham).
- To obtain mesh selection data. 4.

NARRATIVE:

The staff travelled to Conwy by road on 15 June and commenced the survey the following morning. Work continued each day until completion of the six day charter on the 21 June.

RESULTS:

- All 24 stations were successfully completed. 1.
- Stratified samples of otoliths were collected from the required commercial species. 2.

Totals were: Plaice 336, sole 31, cod 15, whiting 128.

- Samples of ungutted plaice, whiting and flounder were collected and frozen for 3. A Franklin (Burnham on Crouch).
- Mesh measurements were not carried out at the end of the cruise. 4.

The help and co-operation given to the staff by the crew of the SILVER STAR was again much appreciated.
